VISION

Every year we screen all the children in the Dallas and Fall City School Districts from K – 5 for vision problems. This is approximately 1200 children. Of those screened about 10% are found to need further screening by a physician. If they are found to need glasses and can't afford them we provide them with the needed glasses.

We provide glasses and hearing aids for the needy in our communities. This is between 20 and 30 eyeglasses and 5-10 hearing aids per year.

Through our association with the Oregon Lions Sight and Hearing Foundation we also able to help with vision surgeries including cataract removal and cornea transplants.

Through our association with the Lions Eyebank of Oregon we help to provide corneas for transplant in Oregon and throughout the United States.

We provide Sight and Hearing screening at the Polk Community Free Clinic.

YOUTH

We offer a \$1000 scholarship to a student at the Dallas High School every year.

We give a small American flag with stand and brochure to all First grade students in Dallas and Falls City.
